


**Week 1 Falconhurst Home Learning Plan- Year 5**

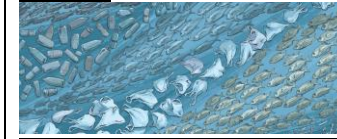
Create a diagram and label it using the scientific language we learnt.

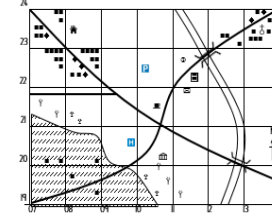
Science: Observe the moon every night. What phase is it in? Keep a moon diary for the next two weeks. Draw and make notes of what you can see. Take photos if you like!
