

What do we mean by a flexible offer?

All children are entitled to 15 hours 'free' pre-school learning from the term after their 3rd birthday. This offer works well for lots of families; but some families would like longer care for their child and some prefer whole day learning instead of 5 afternoons or 5 mornings. Little Falcons Nursery has the ability to offer this flexibility. Very careful planning and organizing of staff makes sure that children are always learning and exploring new ideas whether they stay for a whole day or just a morning session. Activities and opportunities are not repeated in the afternoon for the children who have already spent the morning in the Nursery.

Caring for our Little Falcons also means that we understand how tiring a long day at Nursery can be. For this reason we can make sure that they rest, relax and possibly catch up on a quick nap if that is what they need during a full day session.

What are the different offers?



15 learning hours over 5 mornings each week (8.40am to 11.40am), or 5 afternoons each week (12.00pm to 3.10pm)



Two and a half day provision each week, to include 15 learning hours and 2 lunchtime activity sessions. Children can attend from 8.40 to 3.10pm on Monday and Tuesday with a half day (up to 11.40am) on Wednesday; or half day (from 12.10pm) on Wednesday with full days on Thursday and Friday. As the 2 days require lunchtime care, there will be a charge of £8 per week to cover staffing and resources. Lunch is not provided so children can bring a packed lunch from home, or they can have a hot meal ordered (paid or free school meal).



Full time (30 hour) provision over 5 days to include learning and lunchtime activity sessions. Children attend from 8.40 to 3.10pm during term time. As this offer is greater than the 15 hours covered by the government voucher for all families, some may be eligible for an additional 15 funded hours (subject to HMRC eligibility criteria) whilst some families would be charged £4 per hour for the additional hours. Lunch is not provided so children can go home for lunch, bring a packed lunch from home, or they can have a hot meal ordered (paid or free school meal).
